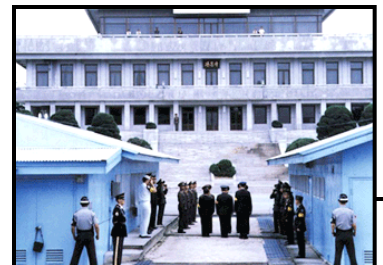
TOUR ITINERARY FOR 3 NIGHTS AND 4 DAYS TOUR

1st Day - Check-in at the Reunion Desk at the the Jamsil Lotte Hotel World lobby and enjoy the dinner sponsored by the Korean-American Association. After dinner, there will be an informative presentation by the USFK Public Affairs Officer on Korea's past and present, the military situation and current events on the Korean Peninsula.

2nd Day – Tour of DMZ/Panmunjom and the 3rd Tunnel followed by a Seoul City Site-Seeing Tour. That evening there will be a reception and dinner in the Jamsil Lotte Hotel World sponsored by 2009 Incheon Global Fair and Festival Organizing Committee, with a presentation of commemorative medals to the Veterans of the Korean War.

3rd Day – Tour of Baekjae Culture, visit Goran-sa Temple & Puyo National Museum. You will also experience Korean traditional method of natural dying and have a dinner of delicious Korean dishes hosted by Puyo-Gun.

4th Day – Check-out of the hotel. Tour of Incheon. Farewell lunch at the Korean restaurant sponsored by the 2009 Incheon Global Fair and Festival Organizing Committee . This ends the Reunion in Korea Program. Buses will be available to take visitors to the Yongsan U.S. military installation in Seoul for those remaining in Korea.

What is the cost for the Reunion in Korea program? Below is the cost for the total package for flight, hotel (Double Occupancy), meals, and tours. These prices exclude taxes. (The tax rate will vary depending on the location and time when ticket is purchased.)

How can you sign up or learn more? Applications will be accepted on a first-received, first-reserved basis until available spaces are filled. A separate application form is required for each family member. Children under the age of 10 are not allowed on the tour.

Other important info:

Deposit and payment: Non-refundable \$100 deposit per family member is required with the application form. Payments may be made by cash, personal check, money order or credit card. Do NOT mail cash.

Passport and visa: Participants are required to be in possession of valid US passport. A Korean Visa is not required if period of stay in Korea is 30 days or less. ***For longer visits, a Korean Visa must be obtained before departure from the United States.***
